<b>ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION FOR STIPULATED JUDGMENT; AND VACATING EVIDENTIARY HEARING</b>	

On March 3, 2017, Complainant Campaign Integrity Watchdog (“Complainant”) and Respondent El Paso County Republican Central Committee (“Respondent”) filed a Stipulation and Joint Motion for Entry of Stipulated Judgment (“Motion”). A proposed Stipulated Judgment was filed with the Motion. The Motion represents settlement between Complainant and Respondent. Respondent has agreed to remit a penalty to the Office of the Secretary of State in the amount of \$50.00 for each of five stipulated reporting violations for a total penalty of \$250.00. In the event that the Respondent fails to return the subject contributions to the contributors identified in the Motion within thirty days of the mailing of this Order, Respondent further agrees to remit an additional penalty to the Office of the Secretary of State in the amount of \$500.00 for each of the five violations for a total additional penalty of \$2,500.00. If the contributions are returned to the contributors within thirty days of the mailing of this Order, then the additional penalty shall not be paid. The parties stipulate that performance of the actions just recited will result in the settlement of the claims raised in this proceeding and seek judgment on that basis.

Good cause appearing therefor, and in the absence of any objection, the ALJ will grant the Motion. The stipulated findings of fact are accepted and the stipulated remittances shall be made within 30 days of the mailing of this Order. These actions will result in the satisfaction of all claims raised in the complaint in this action. Accordingly, the evidentiary hearing previously scheduled to commence on March 7, 2017, will be vacated and the complaint in this matter dismissed.

### ORDER

1. The Stipulation and Joint Motion for Entry of Stipulated Judgment filed on March 3, 2017, by Complainant Campaign Integrity Watchdog and Respondent El Paso

County Republican Central Committee is granted. The Respondent shall make the remittances set forth in the Joint Motion within 30 days of the mailing of this Order;

2. The evidentiary hearing previously scheduled to convene on March 7, 2017, is hereby vacated;

3. The Complaint giving rise to this action is dismissed.
